We also have a brand new product! Cherry juice made by the new mobile fruit press. This juice is concentrated, pasteurized, and packaged in airtight tetra paks allowing the juice to be stored for up to a year unopened, at room temperature, opened up to 2 months...longer if refrigerated. It tastes like grandma's cherry pie!
